





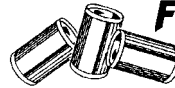

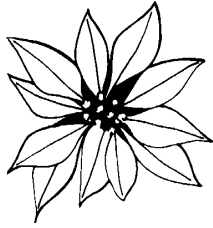
The Living Gospels,

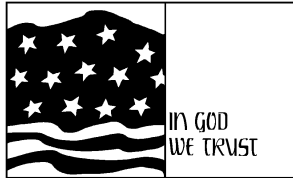
